

MEMO FROM CDI RE: FIRST TIME LICENSE RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS

Prior to AB 2782, bail licensees were required to complete six hours of continuing education for each one-year license term. Because a portion of the required prelicensing education courses cover topics related to bail licensing, six hours of continuing education was waived for new licensees for the first one-year term only. Thereafter licensees had to complete six hour of continuing education each licensing term.

Because there has been no change to the bail prelicensing curriculum, the California Department of Insurance will continue to waive six hours of continuing education for new bail licensees for the first license term. With the passage of AB 2782, bail licensees are now required to complete 12 hours of continuing education each two-year license term. New bail licensees will have six hour of continuing education waived their first license term and will be required to complete the remaining six hours for a total of 12 hours of continuing education.
